

GRANDMA'S TIMELINE

Exploring a typical Western Australian woman's glory box from the 1900s, containing memorabilia from the 90 years of her life

This workshop will explore the 90 years of a West Australian woman's life from 1901 through to 1991 in a visual and interactive manner.

Activities incorporate role play and dress up by school children in costumes of the era.

The workshop will cover the context of the two World Wars, the Depression years and onward to the 90s, following the livelihood of a West Australian family.

Artefacts representing every era from 1900 through to 1990 will be handled, displayed and demonstrated by participants.
